They are young and brimming with ideals. They leave Germany to spend a year as volunteers in Africa, Asia or Latin America, to lend a hand where it's needed, in children's homes or schools. The four-part documentary series **The Volunteers – A Year for the World** tells of young Germans setting off after graduating from school to help out in developing and emerging nations. This is a tale of the desire for adventure, of pining for home, of experiences gained and illusions lost, of growing up in what are initially completely alien surroundings.

In the first program **Great Expectations** (2 January), the youngsters choose which country they plan to visit, and prepare for their trip. Then they set off, leaving their worried parents behind.

Dreams and Reality (9 January) shows their arrival in India, Bolivia and South Africa. The young volunteers must face a variety of new challenges, and cope with the realization that things are not quite as they imagined.

In the third program **Testing Times** (16 January), the young Germans are starting to feel frustrated. They notice just how limited their possibilities are. There is a distinct lack of qualified labor. But even as the dream threatens to become a nightmare, no one is about to give up.

And indeed, the effort turns out to be all worthwhile. In the end, these youngsters find their feet in their respective countries, and a place for themselves within an alien culture. They are learning a great deal for their own future lives, as the program **Home Away From Home** (23 January) reports.

The Berlinale Years

The most important German film festival is celebrating its 60th anniversary in February. With its 250,000 industry visitors, and 270,000 tickets sold, the Berlinale has long been established as a major public attraction and international cultural event. The main focus is the competition for the Golden Bear award.

To mark the anniversary year, **Arts.21** looks back on the festival's turbulent past. Cold War and Nouvelle Vague, world cinema and Zeitgeist – history is reflected in films and at the festival itself. For example, the 1970 Berlinale was dominated by the Vietnam War.

The seven-part series **The Berlinale Years** (from 2 January) highlights some of the most moving moments. From 1954, when Berlin was captivated by Gina Lollobrigida, to 2008, and the triumph of the music movie with the Rolling Stones.

Future Energy Sources

Reserves of coal, oil and gas are disappearing fast – but the world has a huge appetite for power. Hence the urgent need to find new sources of energy. Sun, wind and water have been earmarked as the main suppliers of energy in the future. But their contribution to overall power generation is still small. Scientists and engineers are working to optimize processes, and new ideas are plentiful.

To mark the Year of Science in 2010, **Tomorrow Today** is devoted to the subject of energy. The program features a research project near Cologne, which feeds algae with abundantly available carbon dioxide from a neighboring coal-fired power station. The algae grows rapidly and the resulting biomass is used to produce biogas – just one of many innovative approaches.

Displacement, flight and rape – most of the victims of civil wars are women. At the same time, women are the key to finding peace, Zainab Salbi is convinced of that. Salbi was born in Iraq and lives in the US today, where she has founded the organization “Women for Women International.” It helps women in crisis regions to rebuild their lives. Jaime de Bourbon Parme also wants to get to the root of the problem, and has devised new approaches to dealing with conflicts. And Neeraj Bharadwaj, financial investor from India, is pursuing the question of how globalization is changing the classic global economic division between North and South.

In the five-part series **Young Global Leaders** (from 4 January), **GLOBAL 3000** presents movers and shakers from across the world. They are visionaries and networkers who are at home in many different cultures, and they are the driving force behind a huge variety of projects. Their common goal: to find solutions to global problems.
